- 1 cup water



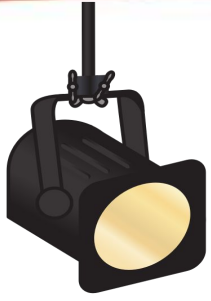
### Another great idea...
