Reading at home

Reading is awesome because you get to learn new words every day and it helps your brain improve more. Instead of just reading at school, you could read at home too. When we read at home, we find books we're interested in. If you read at home you should read half an hour or 20 minutes a day. For example, if you're reading 20 minutes a day you will read about 1.8 million words a year, but if you read only 1 minute a day you read only 8000 words per year. So, if you read 20 minutes a day you improve your brain much more!

Reading also helps people with their vocabulary and helps with their language skills. Reading also helps with kids imagination when reading a book. Reading 20 minutes a day also helps your grammar a lot!
